INSPECTORS UPDATE JUNE 2024

Welcome to June's Stakeholder update.

This month Carlton in Lindrick have faced a real tragedy in the community when a well liked 16 year old, Kamil Hubert-Ziolko died when struck by a falling tree. Two men were arrested on suspicion of manslaughter and a female was arrested on suspicion of assisting an offender. All have been released on bail with strict conditions which we are checking and an investigation which is being led by major crime is taking place. I have been out and attended the site and seen the beautiful flowers, messages and gifts left at the site by members of the community. The community have been exceptional at pulling together and supporting one another. I want to give a special thanks to councillor Steve Scothorne who has ensured young people in the community have had somewhere to go during these difficult times by opening the doors of the youth club.

We have seen a huge spike in shop theft in Worksop Town Centre in recent weeks. I put in a special bid request to the forces' Priority Tasking Team who came to the area and carried out an Operation called FLIPCOIN where we flooded the town centre with plain clothes officers and arrested several of our most prolific shop theives. We will continue to use this operation to send a clear message to those up to no good in the town centre. For any concerns with the town centre please contact Worksop South Sergeant Sarah Hagland.

On 18th June i was invited to the Chief constables Commendation Awards Evening at Force HQ where I was delighted to received a Commendation for my work tackling VAWG. It was an honour to be nominated and to be invited by the chief to receive the commendation (picture below).

I'd like to extend a warm welcome to Nick Wells our new officer for Harworth. Nick has a lot of experience in NPT and will be an asset to our team. Please make contact with him to introduce yourself in the area.

WORKSOP SOUTH

THERE HAS BEEN PLENTY ACTIVITY FROM THE SOUTH TEAM DURING JUNE ON 4TH JUNE A DRUGS WARRANT WAS EXECUTED AT AN ADDRESS ON CHEAPSIDE. NO DRUGS WERE LOCATED ON THIS OCCASION, BUT WE WILL BE CONTINUING TO EXECUTE WARRANTS ON PROPERTIES THAT WE SUSPECT ARE INVOLVED IN DRUG ACTIVITY.

ON 5TH JUNE THE SOUTH TEAM TOOK PART IN OPERATION CLAMPDOWN WHICH IS A JOINT OPERATION WITH THE ENVIRONMENT AGENCY. THIS INVOLVED TARGETING ILLEGAL FISHING DURING THE CLOSED SEASONS. CLUMBER PARK, LANGOLD LAKE, CHESTERFIELD CANAL AND GODFREYS POND WERE ALL COVERED DURING THIS OPERATION. OFFICERS WERE DEPLOYED WITH MEMBERS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL AGENCY TEAM ON FOOT AND PEDAL CYCLES WHICH ENSURED THAT AS MUCH AREA AS POSSIBLE COULD BE COVERED.

ON 9TH JUNE MEMBERS OF THE TEAM HOSTED ANOTHER CYCLE MARKING EVENT AT CARBURTON TEA ROOMS. SEVERAL CYCLISTS ATTENDED TO HAVE THEIR BIKES MARKED AND OTHERS STOPPED AS THEY WERE PASSING THROUGH. ONCE MARKED THE BIKES ARE REGISTERED ON THE BIKEREGISTER DATABASE. THE NEXT MARKING EVENT WILL BE HELD AT WELBECK GARDEN CENTRE ON 21STJULY.

FURTHER ARRESTS AND POSITIVE ACTION FROM THE TEAM THIS MONTH INCLUDE:

- ON 13TH JUNE A MALE AS ARRESTED FOR BEING WANTED FOR RECALL TO PRISON. HE WAS ARRESTED AND RETURN TO HMP TO SERVE REMAINDER OF HIS SENTENCE
- ON 1ST JUNE A VAN WAS LOCATED ON GLADSTONE STREET WORKSOP WHICH WAS IDENTIFIED AS BEING STOLEN FROM LEICESTERSHIRE. THIS VAN WAS RECOVERED AND LEICESTERSHIRE NOW PROGRESSING WITH THIS INVESTIGATION.
- ON 4TH JUNE A MALE WAS ARRESTED AFTER BEING DETAINED BY TWO PCSOS FOR FLEEING THE SCENE OF AN RTC AND WAS ARRESTED FOR DRINK DRIVING AND ASSAULTING ONE OF THE PCSOS. AFTER A SEARCH OF HIS PROPERTY HE WAS ALSO ARRESTED FOR THEFT OF 3 MOTORBIKES. THIS MALE WAS INTERVIEWED AND RELEASED UNDER INVESTIGATION PENDING FURTHER ENQUIRIES.
- ON 13TH JUNE TWO MALES WERE ISSUED WITH SECTION 59 NOTICES FOR RIDING A QUAD AND OFF ROAD MOTORBIKE ON THE KILTON GOLF COURSE.

JUNE SEES THE START EURO 24 - GAMES ARE BEING SHOWN WITHIN THE TOWN CENTRE AND VARIOUS LOCATIONS. THERE WILL BE AN INCREASED POLICE PRESENCE DURING THE ENGLAND GAMES TO ENSURE THAT THESE GAMES ARE ENJOYED BY ALL WITHOUT ANY CRIMINAL ACTIVITY OR ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR.

WORKSOP NORTH



This is your neighbourhood policing update for June for Worksop North.

This month has been busy for the team. We've been working hard to keep our communities safe, and I'm pleased to report some positive results.

- * Stolen motorbike: We assisted our response colleagues in detaining two males who stole a motorbike from Manton Wood. The motorbike failed to stop for the police and crashed on the A57. Thankfully, no one was seriously injured and the two were detained a short distance away.
- * Football patrols: With the England matches, we increased patrols to deter any potential rise in anti-social behaviour. We wish England all the best in the tournament!
- * Shoplifting: Our team has been working alongside local shops in Worksop town centre to tackle shoplifting. Shoplifting can lead to higher prices for everyone, so it's important we assist our Worksop South colleagues with this issue.
- * My team have also arrested a number of people who have been circulated as wanted by the courts.
- * We have seized two off road motor bikes from the Oakham Rise area of Worksop along with an Escooter being ridden illegally.
- * My team spotted a van acting suspiciously on the Sandy Lane area of Worksop. The passenger was wanted for breach of court order in 2023 and the driver tested positive for drugs. Both males were arrested and taken to Mansfield Custody.
- * Drug warrants: This month, we have executed three misuse of drugs act warrants across Worksop and Carlton in Lindrick.
- * Towards the end of this month my team arrested two drunken males for fighting in the town canter at half past eight in the morning. These males were swiftly arrested and taken to custody.

And finally, today 27/06/2024 as I write this update a male has been arrested for obstructing the Nottinghamshire Police Traffic Safety Camera Team on Blyth Road Worksop by stopping them carrying out their important work. This male was transported to Mansfield Custody where he will have to explain his actions.

I'll keep you updated on our work in July.

THE TEAM HAVE ATTENDED SEVERAL EVENTS SO FAR, THOSE BEING AT NORTH LEVERTON, RUFFORD COUNTRY PARK (RURAL CRIME EVENT) AND ORDSALL SUMMER FETE. THERE ARE MORE PLANNED, INCLUDING SOME EVENTS IN KINGS PARK COMING UP SO PLEASE CHECK OUR SOCIAL MEDIA TO SEE WHAT WE ARE UP TO THIS MONTH.

WE HAVE ALSO BEEN VERY PROACTIVE AND MADE SOME EXCELLENT ARRESTS THIS MONTH. THE TEAM QUICKLY ACTED UPON SOME INTELLIGENCE AND AS A RESULT ARRESTED A MALE WHO WAS WANTED AND RECALLED BACK TO PRISON. WE ALSO MADE ANOTHER RECALL ARREST, AND ONE ON BEHALF OF LINCOLNSHIRE WHO WAS WANTED FOR SERIOUS SEXUAL OFFENCES.

THE TEAM ALSO ARRESTED A MALE WHO HAD THREATENED COUNCIL STAFF WHO WAS SUBSEQUENTLY CHARGED AND WILL BE ART COURT IN JULY. PCSO EMMA PORTER WILL ALSO APPLY FOR A CRIMINAL BEHAVIOUR ORDER AGAINST THIS MALE TO PREVENT HIM COMING BACK INTO RETFORD.

PC AL JOHNSON, PC JAMES PICKERSGILL AND I HAVE ALSO SEIZED SEVERAL VEHICLES THIS MONTH WHILST OUT DOING OUR RURAL CRIME PATROLS. SOME FOR BEING USED IN CRIME, NO INSURANCE/ OR TAX AND A SUSPECTED STOLEN MOTORBIKE.

THERE ARE SOME CHANGES TO THE TEAM THIS MONTH WITH PC GLENN TURNER LEAVING FOR A NEW ROLE AND ANOTHER OFFICER WILL REPLACE PC JIM MARTIN UP AT HARWORTH.

PC NICK WELLS WILL JOIN THE TEAM AT HARWORTH FROM 1ST JULY AND IS LOOKING FORWARD TO STARTING WITH US. NICK WAS A FORMER PCSO AND JOINED NOTTINGHAMSHIRE AS A CONSTABLE A FEW YEARS AGO SO HIS PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE ON NPT WILL ALLOW HIM TO GET STUCK STRAIGHT INTO THE ROLE!

THE TEAM ALSO EXECUTED A WARRANT UNDER THE MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT IN RETFORD AND WE WILL BE CONTINUING OUR ENQUIRIES AND HAVE OTHER ADDRESSES NOW ON OUR RADAR. WE ALWAYS WELCOME ANY INFORMATION FROM THE PUBLIC REGARDING DRUG DEALING ACTIVITY AS WE WILL WORK TOGETHER WITH THE COUNCIL AND GET THESE PROPERTIES CLOSED SHOULD THE ASB CONTINUE. WE HAVE SUPPORTED OTHER AGENCIES THROUGHOUT THE MONTH AND HAVE ASSISTED THEM PROGRESSING THEIR ENQUIRIES INTO ORGANISED CRIME IN THE AREA.

ANOTHER PARISH IS NOW UP AND RUNNING WITH COMMUNITY SPEED WATCH, SO THEY HOPEFULLY WILL BE OUT VERY SOON, FEEDING BACK TO US REGARDING PERSISTENT SPEEDERS THROUGH OUR VILLAGES. A REMINDER TO LOOK AT OUR SOCIAL MEDIA TO SEE OUR UPDATES AND UP AND COMING EVENTS.
